Can I increase the verbosity and details of Manager logs?

Solution

Yes, like any application based on abeans, there are properties controlling the verbosity and details of logs.

Edit the file:

• \$ACSDATA/config/jManager/PolicyManager.txt

comment the line:

• abeans.pluggable.acs.logging.LoggingLevelPolicy=INFO

and uncomment:

 $^{\bullet} \ \ \texttt{\#abeans.pluggable.acs.logging.LoggingLevelPolicy=ALL}$
