

Problem

Do I need to "make install" a module after having made changes, to be able to test it?

Solution

If the `$MODPATH` environment variable has been set to 1 before sourcing `.acs/.bash_profile.acs`, one does not have to do a **"make install"**. See [FAQGeneralDevelopmentEnvironmentModpath](#) for more details.
