## Solution

JacORB comes with a number of tools that are very convenient.  
Look into JacORB documentation:

The most interesting are the Interface Repository browser and the Name Service Browser.

Let's first see how you can start them:

- Interface Repository Browser:

```
prompt> irbrowser
```

- Naming Service Browser:

```
prompt> nsbrowser
```
